

The City of Sioux Center has been awarded a \$9,300 Iowa Tourism Grant to launch a tourism-focused Visit Sioux Center website – and we're looking for local photos!

The new Visit Sioux Center website will be a landing page designed to engage potential and current visitors, potential residents and employees, prospective university students and their families, and others curious about Sioux Center, Iowa, or planning to visit or move to the community.

The website is being developed and launched with insights from the local Tourism Steering Committee and tourism stakeholders in various sectors across Sioux Center.

"We want to give a big-picture look at attractions, amenities, restaurants, lodging, shopping, and more here and entice people to dig deeper," said Sioux Center Communications Coordinator Maggie Landegent. Work is beginning this month, and the website is slated to launch by the end of 2025.
